Amendment to LD 579 An Act to Support Farmland Conservation and Transition Planning for Farmers Proposed by Senator Brenner January 11, 2024

Amend the bill by striking the title and inserting the following:

An Act to Support Farmland Conservation

Amend the bill by striking everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §164, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

5. Funding. An account, administered by the department, is established to support publicprivate partnerships to carry out the purposes of this chapter. The account consists of money appropriated to it or received from any other private or public source. The account shall be nonlapsing, and interest in the account shall be credited to it. Unexpended balances at the end of the fiscal year do not lapse but carry over into the next fiscal year.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes and replaces the bill, which is a concept draft. The amendment establishes a separate account administered by the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to support public-private partnerships to carry out the purposes of the Maine Working Farmland Access and Protection Program. The account consists of money appropriated to it or received from any other private or public source.

The amendment also establishes and provides ongoing funding for one full-time, permanent position within the department's Bureau of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources' division of agricultural resource development.
